
Grant Assessment Panel meeting 2024 - Outcome report



Proposals are scored by all Panel members (except those that have a conflict) after presentation by designated Panel members and Panel discussion. Our scoring criteria include both scientific excellence and potential 3Rs impact. Scoring is done independently and anonymously, leading to a single median score. At the end of the meeting, proposals are grouped according to their median scores as a basis for further discussion, which may bring into consideration strategic priorities and portfolio balance. Final funding decisions aim to provide the optimum package of investment.

Median scores of 7 and above are considered fundable, but the funding cut-off is dependent on the budget available at any given Panel meeting. It is not valid to make comparisons across different Panel meetings.

Applications are shown listed in numerical order within blocks according to: i) their median score groups; and ii) their funding outcome. No ranking within blocks should be inferred.

Both outline and full applications are assessed by the Grant Assessment Panel. 89 outline applications were received to this call, of which 22 were invited to submit a full application. A total of 23 applications were received at the full application stage and subsequently discussed by the Panel. One full application had been deferred from the 2023 competition.
