Chief Executive update

3. The Board noted the short oral update from VR on the external operating environment.

External environment

JB and VR had recently participated in a roundtable hosted by Lord Vallance, Minister for Science,
Research and Innovation on non-animal methods. VR informed the Board that Anthony Holmes,

the NC3Rs Director of Science and Technology would remain on secondment at the Office for Life Sciences for a further six months.

NC3Rs strategic review update

- 4. Following the Board meeting in July, VR and theme leads for research funding and innovation had developed three options for the Board to consider with a level core funding scenario. VR presented the options the Board endorsed option 2 based on the flexibility it provided to offer various funding opportunities to support 3Rs model development and the NC3Rs mission, including the ability to leverage co-funding. VR informed the Board that additional scenarios would be presented at its next meeting to meet the requirement to model a 25% cut in funding. This was a closed session.
- 5. Plans for the next five years for the academic engagement and experimental design and reporting programmes were presented by NPdS. The Board were supportive of the proposals. This was a closed session.
